

## Have you heard about CARB's Criteria Pollutant and Toxics Reporting Regulation or CTR?

## Your business may be subject to this new state regulation.

The first year of enhanced reporting under Criteria Pollutants and Toxics Reporting Regulation (CTR) occurs with 2022 emissions data reported in 2023. For the air districts listed below, facilities with backup generators, dry cleaners, metal finishing, solvent usage, or other specified permitted devices/processes are required to report emissions or activity information and other relevant data to their local air district, depending on facility locations and activity levels.

The deadline to submit data to local air districts is **May 1, 2023** (air districts may extend this deadline at their discretion). Call your local air district if you have any questions about submission procedures.
